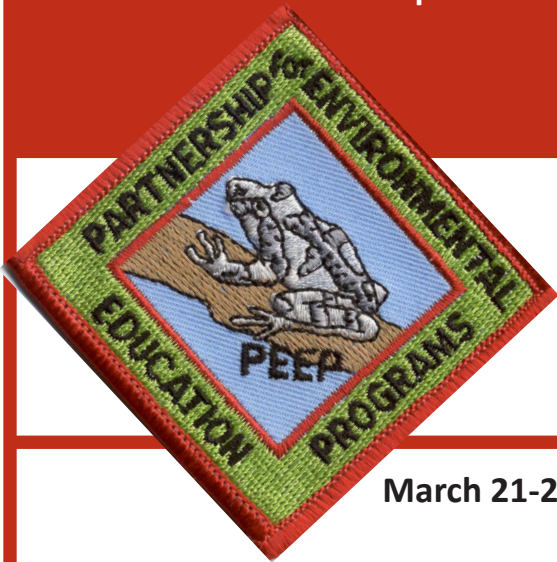




Discover nature on Spring Break with the
